WHAT IS GAS SAFE REGISTER?

Gas Safe Register is the official list of gas engineers in the United Kingdom, Isle of Man and Guernsey. To work legally on gas appliances and installations you must be on the Gas Safe Register. The Register exists to protect the public from unsafe gas work. By becoming a Gas Safe registered engineer you show your customers that you are working legally. It also shows that you are competent and safe to work with gas.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

Before applying to register you will need relevant qualifications and have evidence of your competence. Gas Safe Register only accepts evidence of competence in gas safety such as:

ACS

The Nationally Accredited Certification Scheme is generally referred to as ACS. Its primary function is to ensure that individuals are assessed against a set of national criteria based on current standards, best working practice and technology.

NVQ/SVQ

This covers the City and Guilds awarded 6012 range of Gas Service NVQs for:

- the installation and maintenance of domestic natural gas at levels 2 and 3
 - appliance pathway routes
 - emergency service operations.

Once you have achieved the necessary qualifications and have been awarded evidence of competence for the gas work you are going to do you can apply to register with Gas Safe Register.
